

- Accepted: <u>electronics</u>, tv/monitor, polystyrene, tires, appliances, metal, & cardboard
- Not accepted: <u>Co-mingled/single stream</u>
- Roofing and construction materials not accepted

Salem Twp. Transfer Station

- 4145 29th Street, Dorr, MI
- 8 am 3:30 pm on the 1st and 3rd Saturday of the month. This site is closed January and February.
- Accepted: electronics, tv/monitor (\$3 fee), polystyrene, tires, appliances, metal, & comingled/single stream
- Bulky trash disposal option for a fee
- Roofing and construction materials not accepted

You must present a Resource Recovery Card to drop off materials at these sites. Resource Recovery Cards are available at your local township office
