

**Resolution for August 6, 2024 Primary Election of Cheshire Township, Allegan  
County and State of Michigan Election Commission

1. Call to Order.

Supervisor Steve Revor called the meeting of Election Commission to order at x:xx pm.  
In attendance were Treasurer Hale and Supervisor Revor. Clerk Hetzel Absent.

**RESOLUTION**

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Election Commission of Cheshire Township, Michigan, hereby authorizes Donna Hetzel, Township Clerk, and Keri Erffmeyer, Township Deputy Clerk, to prepare meeting materials for the Election Commission, secure ballots, precinct supplies and polling location necessary and to carry out all other election related duties for Cheshire Township to conduct the Local, County and State Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, August 6, 2024.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Election Commission of Cheshire Township, Michigan, hereby provides that absent voter ballots for the Local, County and State Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, August 6, 2024, be counted in the precinct of Cheshire Township, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there shall be at least one electronic voting device in the precinct of Cheshire Township, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Donna Hetzel, Township Clerk, and Keri Erffmeyer, Township Deputy Clerk, are hereby designated as the authorized assistants of this Election Commission to perform the final inspection on the voting devices to be used at this election, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, MCL 168.679(a) provides the Election Commission of Cheshire Township, by resolution, provides that at an election at which the ballots are counted and certified at the precinct, one or more additional boards of election inspectors be appointed to serve as Receiving Boards, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, Cheshire Township Receiving Board is responsible for the duties as outlined in Section 168.679(a) of the Michigan Election Law (Article 116 of 1954), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the board of the election commission shall appoint two or more election inspectors, with an equal number from each major political party to the Receiving Board prior to each election,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the board of election commission appoints the individuals listed as the election officials for the nine days, July 27 to August 4, 2024, of early in person voting,

and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Donna Hetzel, Township Clerk, shall be responsible for scheduling of the required preliminary and public accuracy tests and inspection of the voting device(s) under the supervision of Keri Erffmeyer and other Allegan County local clerks, on behalf of the Election Commission, present during the Logic and Public Accuracy testing according to the State of Michigan standards, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the persons on the attached list are hereby appointed as election inspectors and receiving board officials for said election in the precinct, with the Cheshire Township Clerk authorized to fill vacancies, if any, as provided by law.
